

Day 16: Hope

Pray that we are giving birth to a new and living hope in the Anglican Mission that is an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. Pray that as we hope in God our strength will be renewed, we will soar on wings like eagles; we will run and not grow weary, walk and not faint. Proclaim our hope in God alone!

Day 17: Maturity

Pray for Priests and Apostles who will prepare God's people for acts of service so that the whole Body of Christ may be built up and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

Day 18: Reconciliation

Pray that there would be reconciliation where there is now division and strife. Pray for the biblical ministry of reconciliation to be poured out in the Anglican Mission as God has committed to us the message of reconciliation through His Word and Spirit. Thank God for reconciling you to Himself in Christ.

Day 19: Healing

Pray healing for those who suffer in mind, body and spirit, as you call on God, Jehovah Rapha our Healer. Pray for the ministry of healing to flourish in all the power of the Holy Spirit within your sphere of influence. Ask God to renew minds and refresh spirits with His resurrection power. Rejoice in the healing mercy of Christ.

Day 20: Anointing

Pray that the Spirit of the Lord would rest upon our leaders – the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might and strength, the Spirit of knowledge and of the reverential fear of the Lord. Praise God that it is neither by might nor power but by His Spirit that we are faithful to the work of the Kingdom.

Apostolic Call

Day 21: Evangelism

Pray for the lost, that the Gospel would be preached to all the ends of the earth and that disciples will be made in every nation and people group. Pray that having counted the cost, we would endure hardship, doing the work of evangelism.

Day 22: Discipleship

Pray that individuals would grow in the grace and knowledge of God, welcoming sound teaching and the discipline of the Lord, that the Word of God would dwell in us richly, that we might teach and admonish one another with all wisdom.

Day 23: Tithing

Pray that we will be people who do not rob God, but bring the whole tithe into the storehouse. Cry out to see the floodgates of heaven open and so much blessing poured out that we will not have room to contain it. Pray for breakthrough and rejoice in God's abundance.

Day 24: Gratitude

Pray that joyful gratitude would characterize our community and flow out in ministry to others. Let us sing, making melody in our hearts to the Lord.

Day 25: Families

Pray that families, as those chosen by God, would put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience with one another, forgiving and speaking blessing to each other. Pray for families to be strong in the Lord, filled with the Spirit and witnesses of God's grace. Give praise for your family.

Day 26: Marriages

Pray for the strengthening of marriages. Pray that couples will honor and care for one another in the love of Christ. Ask God to bless and heal those whom He has joined together, that nothing would drive them asunder.

Day 27: Ministry

Pray for those who minister, and those who receive ministry, that they would discern the move of the Holy Spirit and respond wholeheartedly to the will of God. Pray that people in ministry would be transformed by the renewing of their minds, knowing God's will, that it is good and acceptable and perfect. Praise God for leaders with a servant's heart.

Day 28: Governments

Pray that the Anglican Mission is a light unto the nations. Cry out for justice and righteousness to flow like a river throughout the cities, bringing healing and restoration to the land. Pray for humility and a call to fasting in the Body of Christ as we intercede. Give thanks that God is perfectly just and merciful.

Day 29: Warfare

Pray that we will not grow weary and faint in this battle for souls, but be strong in the whole armor of God, praying at all times in the Spirit. Exalt the name of Jesus above all names, principalities and authorities, demolishing all strongholds, arguments and pretensions that are set up against the knowledge of God. Pray that every thought be brought captive to Christ. Rejoice in the power of Christ's cross.

Day 30: Thankfulness

Give thanks with a pure heart, fervently. Thank God for every perfect gift that comes from above. Rejoice with exceeding joy, worshipping the Lord in the beauty of holiness, saying: "Maranatha: Come, Lord Jesus."

30-Day Prayer Guide

Apostolic Community

Day 1: Word

Pray that God's Word would be proclaimed throughout the Anglican Mission, boldly and clearly. That Jesus, who is the living Word, will be exalted in the preaching and teaching of Scripture. Thank God that He will perform His Word in our midst.

Day 2: Need

Pray for all to hear the truth, acknowledge their need, turn to Jesus for grace, forgiveness and empowerment by His Spirit. Pray that we would be a people who will receive God's promises. Thank God for calling us to Himself.

Day 3: Apostles

Pray that Apostles and apostolic leaders be raised up in the Anglican Mission, called by God and confirmed by God's people; that they would listen for the heartbeat of God for the identity, vision and mission of the church. Thank God for apostolic anointing upon His called ones.

Day 4: Fellowship

Pray that we would be a community characterized by life-giving fellowship. Pray for genuine care and honoring of one another in unity of spirit and the bond of peace. Thank God for one another and for the grace to love each other as Christ loved us.

Day 5: Prayer

Pray that fervent, anointed prayer would be offered to God for the Anglican Mission. Pray that everywhere, people would come boldly to the throne proclaiming God's kingdom come and God's will be done in and through us. Pray for a spirit of prayer to be birthed in our hearts individually and corporately. Thank God that He hears the prayers of His people.

Day 6: Finances

Pray that generosity and abundant provision would flow through the Anglican Mission, in order that we might give to those in need and provide for the work of the kingdom. Thank God that He is able to do immeasurably more than we could imagine, according to His power that is at work within us.

Day 7: Worship

Pray that true and vibrant worship will flow forth, that God will anoint worship leaders to call people into the presence of God. Pray that God's glory will fall upon us as we worship. Thank God for a grateful heart.

Day 8: Growth

Pray for God to add daily to our numbers those who are being saved and those whom He would call into the Anglican Mission. Humbly acknowledge that God provides the growth as we faithfully obey and trust. Rejoice in God's loving kindness that endures forever.

Day 9: Favor

Pray that God's favor would surround us like a shield. Pray that we would bind mercy, kindness and truth about us and write them on our hearts so that we may find favor, good understanding and high esteem in the sight of both God and people. Give thanks that God will bless the righteous.

Day 10: Protection

Pray Psalm 91 for the local, national and international leaders of the Anglican Mission. Pray that God will be the leaders' hiding place and preserve them from trouble, surrounding them with songs of deliverance. Praise God that He will restore what the enemy has tried to steal, kill and destroy.

Apostolic Commitment

Day 11: Unity

Pray that God, Who gives endurance and encouragement, will give us a spirit of unity with one another as we follow Christ Jesus so that with one heart and mouth, we may glorify the God and Father of our Lord. Pray that we would accept one another, just as Christ accepted us, in order to bring praise to God. Thank God for His love which binds every virtue together in perfect unity.

Day 12: Holiness

Pray that as the One Who called us is holy, we might also be holy in all that we do. Cry out for grace to embrace God's discipline as beloved sons and daughters, for the revelation that He disciplines us for our good that we might share in His holiness. Worship the Lord in the majesty and splendor of His holiness.

Day 13: Purity

Pray for purity in thought, word and deed for our leaders. Pray that we would be a people who confess our sins, receive forgiveness and are purified from all unrighteousness. Proclaim that we are a people who, like King David, cry out: "Create in me a pure heart, O God." Take joy in the promise, "The pure in heart will see God."

Day 14: Wisdom

Pray for godly wisdom from above that we would be wise and have understanding in all our choices. That we would not be wise in our own eyes but seek the Lord and His wisdom. Pray for wise strategies and plans to be birthed as leaders meet together. Praise God for wise and discerning hearts.

Day 15: Confidence

Pray that just as Mary, the mother of our Lord, expressed her confidence in God, that we might do the same (Luke 1: 46-55). Pray that as the Holy Spirit overshadows the Anglican Mission, that which is born in it will be of God.
