Spiritual Journey and Growth Questionnaire

To help assess the Postulant’s over-all spiritual suitability for ministry within the Anglican Mission, the Postulant (and spouse) will complete a spiritual journey and growth questionnaire to assist the assessing professional/examiner in the clinical interview.

MMPI -2 (Minnesota Multiphasic Personality Inventory)

The MMPI-2 instrument remains the most widely used and widely researched test of adult psychopathology. Used by clinicians to assist with the diagnosis of mental disorders and the selection of appropriate treatment methods, the MMPI-2 test continues to help meet the assessment needs of mental health professionals in an ever-changing environment.

MBTI - Organization Report (Myers -Briggs Type Indicator)

The MBTI helps individuals gain insight into themselves and how they interact with others. This test sorts people into equally valuable groups to which they already belong and provides a positive and affirming way of describing difficulties associated with type differences.

Enrich

The Enrich Marital Satisfaction scale provides a global measure of satisfaction by surveying several areas of the couple’s marriage. These areas include: communication, conflict resolution, roles, financial concerns, leisure time, sexual relationship, parenting, family and friends, and religion.

Clinical Interview

A two to three hour clinical interview will be conducted in order to focus on the result of the assessment instruments. A two hour clinical interview is recommended for single Postulant and a three hour clinical interview for married Postulant (and spouse).

The spouse of Ordinands will also complete the Spiritual Journey and Growth Questionnaire, MMPI-2, MBTI, and Enrich instruments as well as participate in the clinical interview.

In situations where a postulant must travel to the clinical interview the costs associated with the travel are not covered in the Assessment Fees and are the responsibility of the postulant.
